Helping Your Kids Have a Safe & Spooktacular Halloween 2025

Halloween is just around the corner, and while costumes, candy, and creativity are all part of the fun, safety should always come first. Here are some practical tips to help make this Halloween both magical and safe.

Costume Safety

- Choose costumes with bright colors and reflective details to help your child stay visible in the dark. For extra safety and a fun touch, add glow sticks or light-up accessories for extra visibility.
- Make sure costumes fit well to avoid trips and falls. Avoid long capes or oversized shoes.
- Use face paint instead of masks when possible. Masks can disrupt peripheral vision and make it challenging to locate your child among others wearing the same costume, especially at night.

Trick-or-Treating Tips

- Always accompany young children. Older kids should go in groups and stick to familiar neighborhoods.
- Set a route and curfew. Make sure your child knows where they're allowed to go and when to be home.
- Use sidewalks and crosswalks. Remind kids to look both ways before crossing and to never dart into the street.
- Carry a flashlight or use a phone light to help see and be seen. Make sure flashlights have fresh batteries and phones are fully charged.

Candy Check = Peace of Mind

- Inspect all treats before eating. Discard anything that's unwrapped, homemade (from strangers), or looks suspicious.
- Watch for allergies. If your child has food allergies, sort through their candy together and read labels carefully.
- Moderation is key. Encourage your child to enjoy a few treats now and save the rest for later, just like budgeting money!

Be a Good Neighbor

- Keep your porch well-lit if you're handing out candy.
- Secure pets who might be startled by costumes or doorbells.
- Offer allergy-friendly treats or non-food goodies for kids with dietary restrictions.

Bonus Tip: Make It a Learning Moment

Use Halloween as a fun way to teach kids about decision-making and sharing. Just like SCUBY's candy tips, talk about how they can "spend," "save," "trade," or "give" their candy. These lessons can translate to effective budgeting later in life.
